BOOK AND DVD EXCHANGE

Renovation of the Telephone Box on Main Street, for which the Parish Council has taken over responsibility from BT, should be complete by the first week in May. The cost, initially met by the Parish Council, is being reimbursed by a grant from Councillor Kay Cutts to whom the Council extends its gratitude.

The box is being fitted with shelving so that it can be used as a free exchange facility for books and DVDs, together with some information leaflets.

Residents are invited to donate and borrow books and DVDs, subject to the following conditions:

- People use the facility and the materials donated at their own risk – please take due care. The door is heavy & self-closing, and internal space is restricted. The amount of pavement space adjacent to a busy road is very limited. Small children in particular need close supervision at all times. No warranty can be given about the condition of DVDs and users should ensure that they will not adversely affect their DVD players before use.
- Materials placed in the box become the property of the Parish Council, which will monitor usage. The Council reserves the right to remove and destroy any material which in its view is offensive. If the shelves become full, materials which appear not to have been used for some time may be removed and disposed of to make space for new ones.
