

Beginners' Bridge Lessons

Do you like mental challenges, crosswords, sudoku or card games?

Do you want a stimulating way of relaxing after work?

You can do all or any of these by coming to Beginners' Bridge. Bridge is a game for all ages from teenagers to 90 year olds.

Each session in a series of 10 involves tutor input and practice in a friendly and relaxed atmosphere at the Royal Oak in East Bridgford. A course booklet is available covering everything on the course so there is no need for note taking. No previous knowledge of Bridge is assumed and participants should, by the end, be able to play rubber bridge at a social level using the Acol system of bidding. The course leads on naturally to an improvers' course in the spring. You do not need a partner.

The lessons will be on Thursday evenings from 7.30pm to 10 pm starting in the Royal Oak, Main Street, East Bridgford on 27th Sept. The cost is £60. Come along and sample the first two lessons with no commitment.
