The Proposed Butt Lane Development

There is soon likely to be a planning application up for consultation to build a substantial development of housing between Butt Lane and Closes Side Lane on the east side of the village heading towards the A46.

At this time the planning application for the development has not yet been made available on the Rushcliffe Borough Council web site. Therefore we can't give you all the details about the application but we can inform you that it is likely to be publicised soon and we can explain some of the ways in which you could have your opinions heard once it is.

Until the application is made public and we can see what is actually being proposed, all we have is speculation about what may be in the final application. We would suggest that you wait until the application is made public and then we can all see what is really being proposed, before you make comment.

The Parish Council wants to ensure that as many people as wish to voice their opinion have an opportunity to do so. The following are some ways you might do this.

By commenting on the Rushcliffe Borough Council planning web site once the application is made public (<https://planningon-line.rushcliffe.gov.uk/online-applications/>).

Searching for status of 'current' and keyword 'East Bridgford' you get a list of all the open planning applications. If you select the relevant application you can make a public comment via the 'comments' tab.

By phoning Rushcliffe Borough Council telling them your views on: 0115 981 991

Currently there is no case officer so it is not possible to leave a comment this way.

By sending an email to us stating your opinions to: parishcouncil@eastbridgford.com

By voicing your views to a Parish Councillor who will share it at the Parish Council meeting or to our Borough Councillor, Cllr David Simms (cllr.dsimm@rushcliffe.gov.uk).

By attending the Parish Council meeting which will decide on its response to Rushcliffe Borough Council as a statutory consultee.

The date of this meeting is currently not yet set but when it is you can attend as a member of the public and state your opinion directly to the Parish Council. The agenda for the meeting will be published before the meeting and will be available on the village web site and notice boards.

If it is a virtual meeting, guidance on how to attend will also be published.
