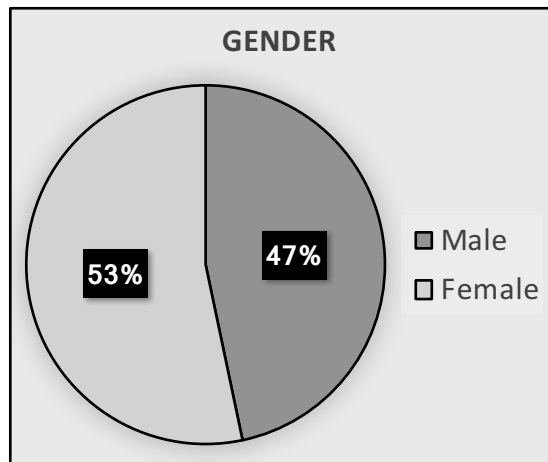

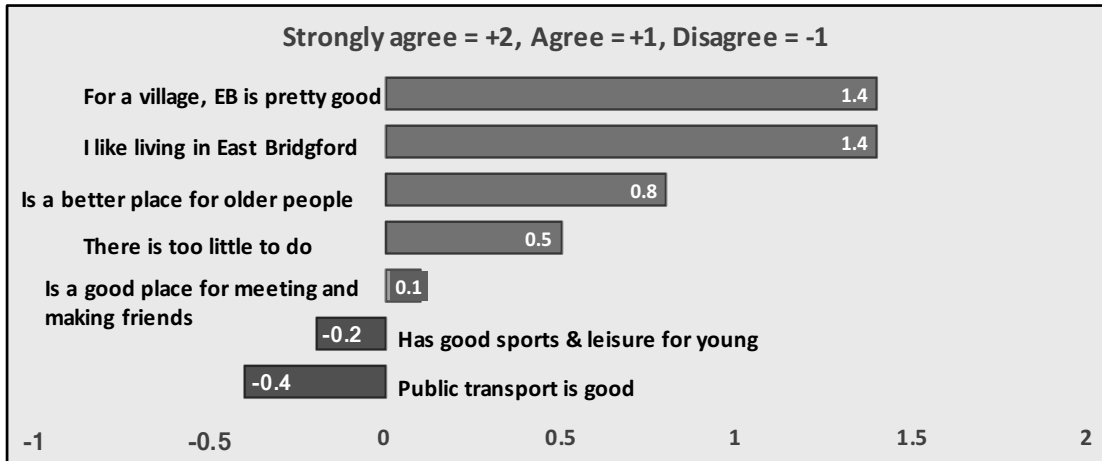

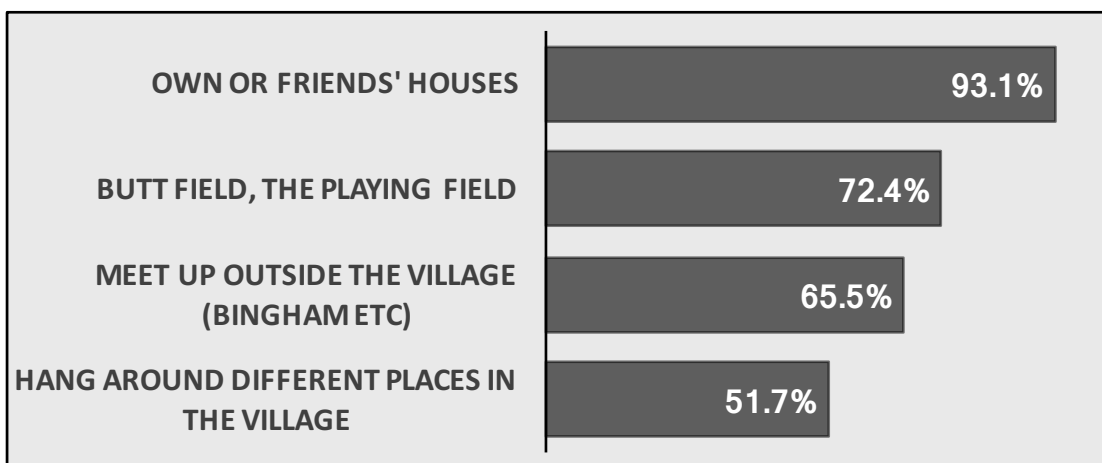
Q1 & 2. AGE AND GENDER



Q3. What is living in East Bridgford like for you? (32 responses)

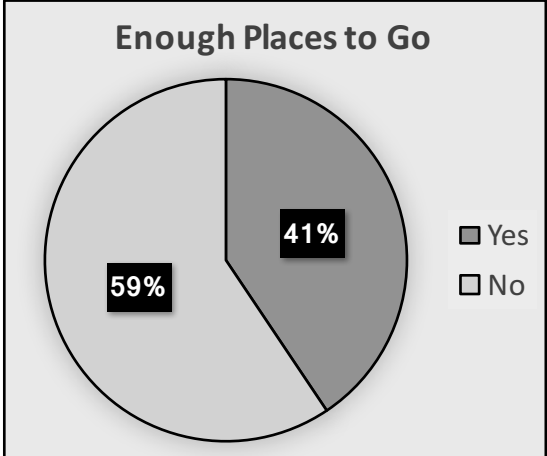


Q4. If you meet up with friends in East Bridgford, where do you go?

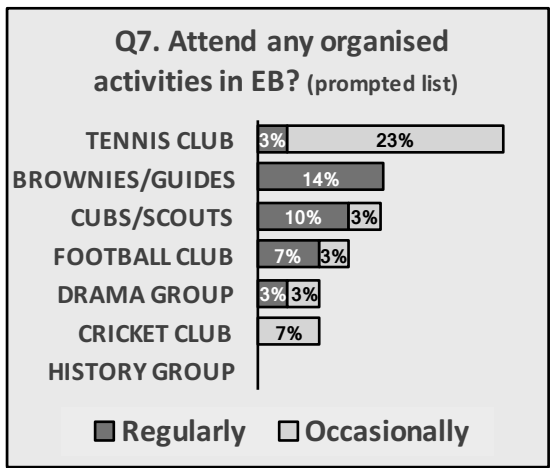


Q5. If there is anywhere else you often meet?

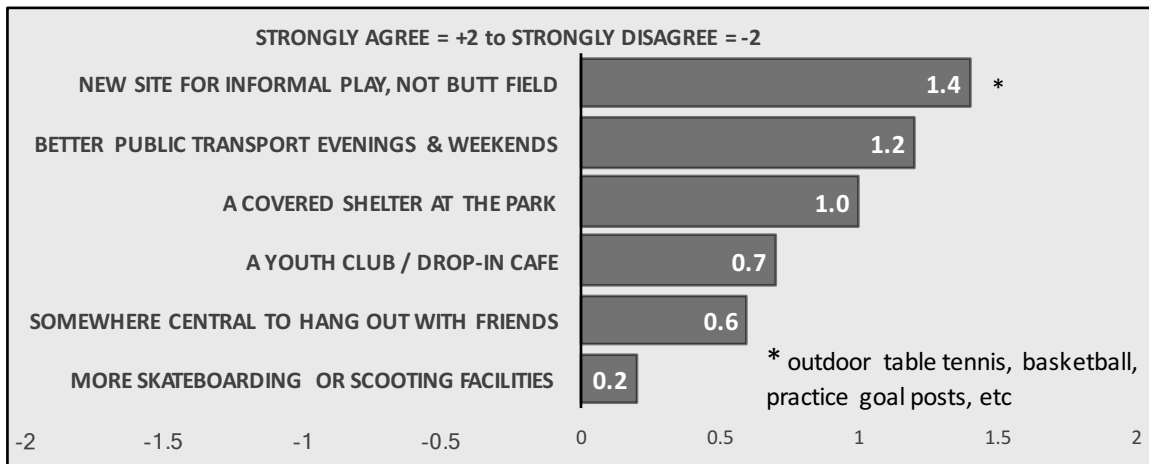

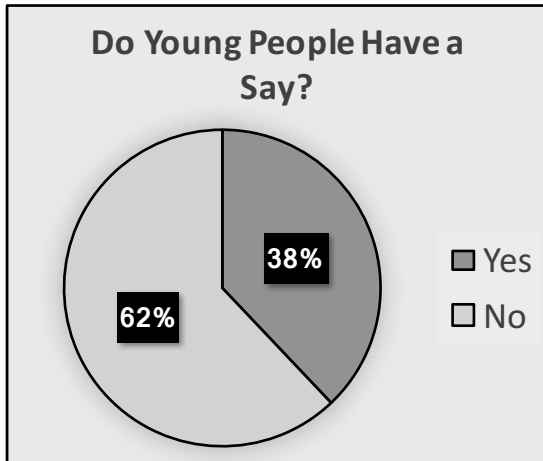
